She was the lead author for *Celebrating Families!*™ and supervised its adaptation, *¡Celebrando Familias!*, for mono-lingual Spanish speaking families and the new 0-3 component. Group models created by her teams have been successfully replicated throughout the US, Mexico, and Russia. Honors include: the 2012 Vernon Johnson Award from Faces & Voices; the 2010 California State Director's Award for Cultural Diversity; and 2008 selection as one of NACoA's 25 individuals who "save, protect and guide children of alcoholics".
