Professional Development Trainings Registration Policies for ABC Training

The Inclusion Collaborative (IC) provides professional development to improve child and family outcomes for children with and without disabilities and/or special needs¹ so that they may have equal access to full participation in inclusive learning and community environments.

Registration:

Registrations must be completed online, by fax or by mail. NO registrations will be accepted by phone or email. Participant must have a valid email address in order to register. Registration will close one week prior to training date or until registration is full (some exceptions may apply). You will receive an email of your “pending” registration until your payment is received. Once payment is received you will receive a “confirmation” email. Payments must be received before closing date; **no payments will be received at the door. No walk-ins will be allowed in.** Cancellations should be done by email or phone, no refunds will be issued.

Fees:

- Training fees are the sole responsibility of the registrant. If your school, district or agency is paying for your registration, it is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure payment is received. No invoices will be sent, please use pending email received for proof of payment required. Payments are due one week prior to training.*
